EMERGENCY COMMUNICATION SERVICES**

Official Uniform Requirements

All members Level 2 and above are required to have the following uniform and wear it when assigned. Sections 1 and 2 are mandatory as the complete uniform. Sections 3 and 4 are optional.

1. WORK UNIFORM – MALE & FEMALE (class B)

a. Pants:

Navy blue Lyon (item #130, midnight blue) or Setlo pants.
[Available at Greenwood's Uniforms for approximately \$35]

Work-Rite 4007NN Nomex (optional).
[Available at Greenwood's Uniforms for approximately \$75]
[Available at Fire Dept. Warehouse for approximately \$58]

No denim type pants allowed.

b. Shirts:

Officers (Chiefs) - White with epaulets on shoulders and two (2) button-down pockets. Long sleeves (style #175R5100) or short sleeves (style #75R5100) appropriate.
[Available at Greenwood's Uniforms for approximately \$22 - \$27]

Captains and All Others - Blue Fire with two (2) button-down pockets. Long or short sleeves (Lyon's style #1540) appropriate.
[Available at Greenwood's Uniforms for approximately \$27 - \$29]

c. Socks: Dark blue or black, if visible.

d. Shoes/Boots: Black lace up type leather shoe, plain toe. Sorrel type or military style boot, black in color, lug type soles.

e. Belt: Basket weave, 1-3/4 or 1-1/2 inch, black, with chrome 'D-ring' buckle.
[Available at Greenwood's Uniforms for approximately \$14 - \$16]

2. PATCHES & NAME TAG

- a. Left Sleeve Blue Fire (obtain from ECS STAFF)
- b. Right Sleeve SBCO. ECS (obtain from ECS STAFF)
- c. Over Right Pocket Silver-colored Metal Name Tag with first initial, last name, and callsign in black ink. (Brass-colored for Chiefs.)
[Available at Greenwood's Uniforms (#6 Plate) for approximately \$6]

3. OPTIONAL WORK UNIFORM CLOTHING - MALE AND FEMALE

- a. Golf Shirts: Department approved Golf-type shirt with department logo. Colors to be approved by the Chief Officer in charge of the division. Chiefs' shirts to be white, All others to be bright royal blue. [Order from ECS STAFF, approximately \$25- \$29]
- b. Jackets: Navy blue, cloth-type "Lyon" Item #3432 with removable zip-in liner.(Available at Greenwoods Uniforms for approximately \$80)
- c. Parka: department approved wear guard deluxe winter storm mountain parka #1452. [Available from Fire Dept. Warehouse \$75]
- d. Baseball cap: Fire Department approved only. In no case may the baseball cap be worn in lieu of the safety helmet as required by the Fire Department. Not to be worn inside buildings except fire facilities. No unauthorized pins, patches or logos. Caps may also be worn on outside activities including training exercises, fire camps, work details and special approved functions. [May NOT be purchased. This is ONLY issued from Chief Officer.]
- e. Coveralls: PRO-TUFF style #US 101 with Department patch on left shoulder & ECS patch on right shoulder. Military style namestrip may be used over right pocket. (Blue background with white letters)
- f. Sunglasses: Sunglasses, with conservative type frames, will be allowed. Type based on preference and eye sensitivity. Eye class retainers shall be either navy blue or black with no designs or lettering.

WEARING THE UNIFORM

The uniform is intended to be worn at all times when on duty, and also during such activities as public education programs, demonstrations, and all circumstances when in contact with the public and representing the organization.

The foregoing may be only a partial list of occasions when the uniform is to be worn. The Chief Officer will be the final authority as to the wearing of the uniform.

The uniform may NOT be worn to non-approved functions or events.
